

Swipe your finger along a dusty barrel and step back in time, reimagine the gold rush days of Western Victoria and take home treasures from your journey.

A family. A story. A nostalgic insight.

From the French establishment of Chateau Remy, to the Two Hats awarded to the Royal Mail Hotel - be captivated by the historical moments highlighted throughout this culinary itinerary.

Tour the visually spectacular southern extremity of the Great Dividing Range, where warmer days and cooler nights have allowed for a wealth of grape varieties to be grown since planting began in 1863 at St Peters Vineyard.

Pre-booked tours and cellar door stories of pioneers, heritage buildings, generations of winemakers and gold rush days will have you settling in with a Shiraz for more.

This itinerary is not all about stepping back in time. Recently, a new generation of winemakers are emerging in the region, experimenting with techniques and pushing boundaries, making a little history of their own.





Friday Dunkeld to Great Western

After a night at The Royal Mail Hotel, grab a bakery delight for your journey to explore the heritage listed labyrinth of tunnels at Seppelt Wines, Australia's largest underground cellars.

Saturday Great Western to Moonambel (via Ararat & Redbank)

tunnels and Concongella Cellar Walk at Best's Wines before making your way to the Pyrenees to be engrossed by stories told of winemaking generations.

Explore the hand dug

Sunday Avoca to Ballarat

(via Warrak & Beaufort) Make up a picnic lunch from Pyrenees Farmhouse before setting off to explore the back roads to Beaufort. Continue your historic getaway in Ballarat where the gold rush began in 1851.

A starry sky. A quiet drive. A French tradition.


Named the Pyrenees in 1836 by European explorer Major Thomas Mitchell as it reminded him of France's Pyrenees region, the first vines were planted in the area in 1848 by a man named MacKereth.

His winery supported the three wine shops in Avoca until he sold up to a clergyman named Dawson, who promptly uprooted the vines, shut the winery and destroyed the cellars.

It wasn't until 1961 that the terroir romanced Château Remy to the region, a winery we know now as Blue Pyrenees Estate. Nowadays, this grape grower's paradise is dotted with over 30 wineries along with culinary experiences, from Spanish tapas through to the bespoke delights of farmer's markets.

So let the magic of food, wine and a game of pétanque bring you closer together during a dreamy weekend escape.

After lunch for two and an afternoon stroll, take pleasure in a game of pétanque at Mount Avoca, then soak up the beautifully renovated and romantic interior of The Avoca.




